**Bill Summary and  
Fiscal Analysis:**

SB 1264 specifies “great bodily injury” to include prolonged pain, concussions, and injuries to more than 10% of the body. The measure also updates statutory language relating to domestic assault to match the felony classification system.

The Department of Corrections notes any incarceration increases would be dependent on the number of future convictions, and the agency is unable to determine a fiscal impact. The Department has provided the marginal/incremental cost of an incarcerated inmate, which is \$67.26 per day or \$24,549.90 per year.
