**Bill Summary and  
Fiscal Analysis:**

SB 1294 prohibits the Office of Juvenile Affairs and the Department of Corrections from charging a fee to place a phone call within a facility operated by the Office or the Department.

The fiscal impact of the measure is an annual revenue loss of approximately \$3 million to the Department of Corrections. The Office of Juvenile Affairs does not currently operate any juvenile detention facilities and is not the entity collecting any fees assessed by the contracted entity. To the extent that any juvenile facility is currently charging for phone calls, the loss of revenue would be to the county or other contracted operator of the facility.
