**Bill Summary and  
Fiscal Analysis:**

SB 1305 authorizes the OMMA to approve a third-party vendor to provide educational training to employees of medical marijuana businesses.

As the proposal does not require OMMA to provide or fund the training, there is no fiscal impact as written. OMMA shares that any administrative workload can be absorbed within existing resources.
