**Bill Summary and
Fiscal Analysis:**

SB 1325 requires any defendant charged with domestic abuse to have a GPS device attached to them as a condition for bail. The defendant will pay for the cost of the device, and the Department of Corrections (DOC) will monitor the defendant until the conclusion of their case.

The DOC incurs costs related to GPS monitoring, including an equipment cost of approximately \$800 per unit if lost and a daily monitoring cost of approximately \$3.89 per active monitor. Any fiscal impact to the DOC would be associated with staff labor required for supervision, contingent upon statutory authority permitting the DOC to supervise defendants prior to sentencing. Due to the uncertainties, a fiscal impact cannot be reasonably estimated at this time.
