**Bill Summary and
Fiscal Analysis:**

SB 1335 states that campus police officers employed by institutions of higher education and public school district boards of education are required to complete a minimum of 6 hours of sexual assault and violence training. It states that current campus police officers who have not completed the training will have 1 year to complete it.

The fiscal impact of the measure for FY'27 is estimated to be between \$37,500 and \$162,500 based on the delivery of either online or in-person courses and the number of employees in each department. This estimated cost would include all 25 public colleges and universities. The estimated cost per new applicant would be between \$50 and \$60 a person if the training is delivered online and between \$260 and \$400 a person if the training is delivered in person.
