Bill Summary and Fiscal Analysis:

SB 1350 establishes the Oklahoma State Data Center at the Oklahoma Department of Commerce to be the primary center for applied population research for the state and be the official contact with the United States Bureau of the Census. The duties of the Center include preparing, maintaining, and interpreting population statistics, cooperating and giving assistance to other state agencies and organization in demographic information, and shall prepare a biennial report on the state of the state's population for electronic submission to the Governor and Legislature with policy implications of population trends.

The measure also creates the Oklahoma State Data Center Revolving Fund and appropriates \$500,000 to the fund.

The Department of Commerce states that the appropriation is sufficient for the establishment of the Center and the hiring of a state demographer, as required in the measure. There is no fiscal impact to the agency outside of the appropriation.
