Bill Summary and Fiscal Analysis:

SB 1357 directs the state to match funds for federal grant funds received by the state through the Adult Education and Family Literacy Act on a dollar-for-dollar basis, subject to available funding. The measure directs the state to continue the program at a rate equal to twice the last full year of federal grant funds received from the program if the federal program is ended and no successor program is named.

CareerTech currently receives \$7,920,330 in grant funding through the federal Adult Education and Family Literacy Act. The agency anticipates matching the grant funds dollar-for-dollar, with no further local or in-kind contributions, would require \$7,255,120.00 in additional appropriated funds. If the grant funding program were discontinued at the federal level the impact to state appropriations rises to \$15,840,660.00.
