**Bill Summary and  
Fiscal Analysis:**

SB 1365 exempts purchases under \$75,000 made by the OTRD from the provisions of the Oklahoma Central Purchasing Act if they are related to merchandise for resale purchased for and sold by the Department. The proposal clarifies that this exemption shall not apply to leasing or contracting state-owned restaurants in state parks.

The OTRD states there will not be a fiscal impact but will allow more purchasing flexibility with resale merchandise.
