**Bill Summary and  
Fiscal Analysis:**

SB 1376 strikes language authorizing the Adjutant General to arm members of the state military forces on military installations and other places, authorizes the Adjutant General to define the purpose of any bequests as authorized by law, provides that a soldier informed by an officer's intent to subject him or her to judicial punishment shall have 3 days instead of 45 days to provide a response if the soldier is on active duty, and alters compensation for National Guard Members in certain circumstances.

The OMD anticipates an annual impact of between \$5,000,000-\$7,000,000 annually; depending on the number of National Guard servicemembers that are eligible and choose to retire in the Supplemental Retirement Pay Plan.
