**Bill Summary and  
Fiscal Analysis:**

SB 1382 establishes the Diabetes Prevention Program at OHCA. The program shall be an evidence-based, lifestyle change program designed to prevent or delay the onset of type 2 diabetes among individuals with prediabetes. Members may participate in up to 22 sessions with a peer coach annually and reimbursements shall be no greater than 80% of the Medicare reimbursement rate.

The Authority estimates a total cost of \$468,000 to fully implement the program with a state share of approximately \$168,000 annually.
