**Bill Summary and
Fiscal Analysis:**

SB 1386 directs the Supreme Court to implement policies that govern court audio and video recording, broadcasting, livestreaming, and the preservation of public access of judicial records and directs the Administrative Office of the Courts to develop the guidelines. The measure provides that the policies should include standards on livestreaming court proceedings and states that the court can restrict recording, broadcasting, or livestreaming upon findings supported by evidence that a compelling interest requires restriction. The measure also states that all court recording systems should support the creation of AI-assisted transcripts.

The fiscal impact of the measure for the first year of implementation is \$28,559,074 with costs including hardware costs and initial software setup and support. The annual recurring fiscal impact is \$73,789,974 consisting of costs related to hardware support, software support, live captioning and additional personnel to operate and maintain the provisions of the measure.
