#### **Bill Summary and Fiscal Analysis:**

SB 1442 amends the definition of distiller to any person who produces 2,400 proof gallons or more annually of spirits and changes the annual license fee for distillers from \$3,125.00 to \$1,000.00. The proposal creates a micro-distiller license for those who produce less than 2,400 proof gallons annually of spirits and sets their annual license fee to \$325.00.

ABLE shares to create the new license would cost approximately \$7,000 for software coding tweaks. There are currently 13 licensed distillers in Oklahoma that bring \$40,625 in annual license fees. If all 13 distillers produce more than 2,400 proof gallons, the total collection in fees would amount to \$13,000. If the distillers produce less than 2,400 proof gallons, the total collection in fees would amount to \$4,225.

The total fiscal impact ranges from \$34,625 to \$43,400.
