**Bill Summary and
Fiscal Analysis:**

SB 1446 changes the minimum penalty to 10 years of imprisonment for people convicted of child sex trafficking.

A review of current population data identified six inmates incarcerated for these offenses. Two of the six are serving life sentences or sentences exceeding 50 years. The remaining four inmates have an average sentence length of approximately 5.25 years. Under the proposed measure, the four inmates would be subject to an additional estimated 4.75 years of incarceration to meet the new minimum penalty threshold. Based on the marginal daily cost of incarceration, the estimated additional cost associated with extending incarceration for these four inmates is approximately \$147,438. This value is subject to change based on the number of future convictions.
