**Bill Summary and
Fiscal Analysis:**

SB 1447 provides that no contract between the Oklahoma Employees Insurance Plan and a pharmacy benefits manager (PBM) is to be awarded to a PBM that has settled a lawsuit, been fined, or had judgement over \$4,000,000 in the previous five years. The proposal provides that the scoring of a request for proposal (RFP) shall include favorable treatment for any bidder who has been domiciled in Oklahoma for at least one year on the date of the release of the RFP, and disfavor a PBM that has a corporate structure that includes a health insurance company, retail pharmacy chain, specialty pharmacy business, mail-order pharmacy business, or pharmaceutical manufacturer.

The Oklahoma Health Care Authority shares that a fiscal impact is undeterminable. They share that if EGID is statutorily prohibited from awarding the contract to a significant portion of the market, their ability to award the RFP to the most-cost effective bidder is diminished, likely resulting in a substantial fiscal impact.
