**Bill Summary and  
Fiscal Analysis:**

SB 1451 directs the State Election Board to modify voter registration forms by including a space that indicates whether a voter was previously registered to vote in another country or state and if so, a space or section to indicate his or her prior registration information

The State Election Board is anticipating a one-time cost of no more than \$25,000 for the measure with costs related to the printing of new voter registration applications, programming of the election conduct software, and training for County Election Board personnel. Service Oklahoma is anticipating a minimal to none cost.

Fiscal impact provided by the State Election Board and Service Oklahoma.
