**Bill Summary and
Fiscal Analysis:**

SB 1451 directs the State Election Board to modify voter registration forms by including a space that indicates whether a voter was previously registered to vote in another state, the address the voter was previously registered in another state, and a statement for the voter to sign indicating he or she wants his or her previous registration cancelled. Upon receiving the registration of a voter who filled out the newly included spaces, the State Election Board shall transmit the voter's request for cancellation of registration to the appropriate jurisdiction.

The State Election Board is anticipating a one-time cost of no more than \$25,000 for the measure with costs related to the printing of new voter registration applications, programming of the election conduct software, and training for County Election Board personnel. Service Oklahoma is anticipating a one-time cost of \$75,000 for the measure. Implementation would require programming changes to the driver license and identification card application systems, updates to data validation and storage logic, and development work to enable the secure transfer of additional voter registration data to the State Election Board in accordance with the bill's requirements.
