#### **Bill Summary and Fiscal Analysis:**

SB 1477 clarifies that language allowing individuals over the age of 21 and under the age of 30 to complete high school does not allow such individuals to participate in concurrent enrollment. The measure further clarifies that students must be at least age 13 but not 21 or older to participate in concurrent enrollment.
