### Bill Summary and Fiscal Analysis:

SB 1494 directs the Legislature to appropriate adequate funding to the State Board of Education to fully fund flexible benefit allowances for employees of school districts that provide in-person classroom instruction for a minimum of 170 days or the equivalent number of hours. For school districts that provide in-person classroom instruction for fewer than 170 days or the equivalent number of hours, the bill directs the Legislature to appropriate adequate funding to fully fund flexible benefit allowances at the Plan Year 2026 rate.
