**Bill Summary and
Fiscal Analysis:**

SB 1511 requires businesses or people that employs a person registered to the Sex Offenders Registration Act to post signage stating that their business employs a registered offender if the business provides services where children are expected to be present. The measure establishes a misdemeanor for failing to comply, as well as a maximum \$1,000.00 fine.

The fiscal impact of this measure is a possible increase to fees and fines.
