Bill Summary and Fiscal Analysis:

SB 1540 adds the crime of grooming to the list of Class B6 crimes. Convicted persons of this crime will be guilty of a felony and subject to a maximum term of imprisonment of 10 years and/or a maximum fine of \$10,000.

The Department of Corrections notes any incarceration increases would be dependent on the number of future convictions, and the agency is unable to determine a fiscal impact. The Department has provided the marginal/incremental cost of an incarcerated inmate, which is \$67.26 per day or \$24,549.90 per year.
