**Bill Summary and  
Fiscal Analysis:**

SB 1602 states that the board of trustees of a law library in counties with a population of over 500,000 residents will authorize any funds in excess of 25% of the income into the State Judicial Revolving Fund. The measure also increases the fee to be assessed and credited into the Law Library Fund for counties having a population of over 500,000 residents from \$6 to \$12.

The measure yields a \$35,635 transfer of funds from the Law Library Fund to the State Judicial Revolving Fund. Additionally, the measure yields an approximate combined increase of \$553,498 in fees collected to Oklahoma and Tulsa County.

The measure yields no fiscal impact to state revenue.
