**Bill Summary and
Fiscal Analysis:**

SB 1608 adds school location and employer to be provided as searchable terms on the Mary Rippy Violent Crime Offenders Registry and the Oklahoma Sex Offender Registry.

The fiscal impact of the measure is an estimated one-time cost of \$7,360 to the Department of Corrections. Implementation would require modifications to the Violent Offender Registry applications with an estimated labor cost of 64 hours at an hourly rate of \$115. Modifications would be required in two separate software applications: the internal system used by agency staff and the public-facing application. The dual-system structure exists due to the implementation of the Mary Rippy Act following the development of the Sex Offender Registry.
