#### **Bill Summary and Fiscal Analysis:**

SB 1193 expands allowable uses of the Teacher Empowerment Revolving Fund to include compensation for teachers certified in special education and increases the required salary differential for certified special education teachers from 5% to 10% above the prevailing wage of non-special education teachers in the same district.

SDE anticipates a projected fiscal impact of \$2,413,145 in Teacher Empowerment Revolving based on an estimate of 951 Special Education Teachers at an average salary of \$50,750 times 5% per teacher supplement of \$2,537.
