Bill Summary and Fiscal Analysis:

SB1628 prohibits the issuance of new non-domiciled commercial learner permits and non-domiciled commercial driver licenses.

Historically, a small number of non-domiciled CDL applications have been processed by SOK. Elimination of this credentialing is expected to reduce collections of application and issuance fees associated with non-domiciled commercial credentials. The decrease in revenue would be minimal.
