**Bill Summary and  
Fiscal Analysis:**

SB 1648 requires OHCA to provide coverage and reimbursement for prenatal, delivery, and postpartum services. Such services shall be reimbursed separately and shall not be reimbursed through a global payment or an all-inclusive payment methodology for maternity services. These services shall include at a minimum: office visits, laboratory fees, physician-ordered testing, blood work, remote monitoring, fetal nonstress tests, and continuous glucose monitors or other services for gestational diabetes when medically necessary.

The Authority estimates a total cost of the measure to be between \$10-12 million.
