**Bill Summary and  
Fiscal Analysis:**

SB 1660 prohibits the court from issuing any order regarding imposing restrictions on custody orders on a Saturday or Sunday or past 10:00 a.m. on a Friday. The measure also directs the court to order the Oklahoma Department of Human Services to pay damages to the family equal to 7 times the payment the department is entitled to receive from the federal government for the care of the child.

The Oklahoma Department of Human Services is estimating a cost of \$779,000 for the measure. This estimate was found by averaging the number of children in the population returned to parents within a 10-day period and the reimbursement amount per child, multiplied by 7.
