**Bill Summary and  
Fiscal Analysis:**

SB 1706 prohibits any foreign adversary or foreign principal from renting or holding a controlling interest in a data center. The Attorney General will determine whether an entity is subject to the provisions of this measure. If an entity holds an interest or rents a data center, the Attorney General will initiate an action in district court within the jurisdiction of the real property.

The fiscal impact of this measure is undeterminable since involvement with the Attorney General will be specific to the facts of any one data center.
