**Bill Summary and
Fiscal Analysis:**

SB 1773 creates a misdemeanor and states that any person who knowingly provides a false as it relates to child safety and custody will be guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by a maximum fine of \$500, imprisonment in the county jail for a maximum of 3 months, or by both fine and imprisonment in the county jail. The measure also states that any individual who has been convicted will be liable for damages brought by the false statement. The state will notify all parties involved in the case, as well as the person who provided the false statement, and the notice can be used as evidence against the person who made the false statement.

The fiscal impact of this measure is possible increase to fees and fines.
