**Bill Summary and
Fiscal Analysis:**

SB 1778 amends the Strong Readers Act to provide for intensive intervention services, summer academy programs, student promotion and retention, transitional classroom instruction, targeted transitional instruction, and screening for students in grades 1-3.

As there is no funding requirement or appropriation attached to the bill, there is no impact. SDE reports that a vendor currently provides a statewide reading platform to screen students in kindergarten through third grade, and as such no impact is expected with regards to screening. The interventions mentioned in the bill are not identified as a state expense.
