**Bill Summary and  
Fiscal Analysis:**

SB 1791 requires the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Commission and the Military Department to identify state parks that can be designated as veteran and active-duty personnel access areas for recreational use.

The land owned and leased by the Military Department is not available for public use to include hunting, fishing, hiking and camping with the exception of Camp Gruber at Braggs, OK. Through an MOU with the Department of Wildlife Conservation, those activities at Camp Gruber are authorized in designated areas that are primitive sites not equipped with public restrooms or amenities for disabled personnel. The estimated cost to add restrooms and picnic areas that are handicap accessible is \$500,000. This Fiscal Impact is incomplete; data from the OTRC is necessary for a complete impact and is pending.
