**Bill Summary and  
Fiscal Analysis:**

SB 1806 has DHS extend foster care services to support individuals transitioning into adulthood who meet certain requirements. Individuals must have been in DHS custody on their 18<sup>th</sup> birthday but are less than 21; or achieved legal permanency or adoption at 16 or older but are younger than 21 and the legal caretaker is no longer able or willing to care for the individual. The individual must also meet certain educational or employment qualifications unless they cannot due to medical conditions.

DHS estimates an additional 2,600 individuals would be covered by this measure. The Department estimates a total cost of \$28,011,000 with a state share of \$14,040,000.
