**Bill Summary and  
Fiscal Analysis:**

SB 1807 establishes a single Quality of Care assessment rate for all facilities participating on the program. This would rate the current assessment rates for 17 continuum of care facilities and 2 nursing facilities.

OHCA anticipates an additional \$5,117,952 in fees paid by participants which in turn would bring in an additional \$10,214,438 to the program. These funds are given back to facilities that meet certain metrics therefore there is no fiscal impact on this measure.
