**Bill Summary and  
Fiscal Analysis:**

SB 1818 requires any person or entity authorized to commence industrial, municipal and commercial operations to disclose the use of biosolids when labeling products for sale and distribution. The measure requires the disclosing of the use of biosolids by placing signage on any property where biosolids are utilized. The DEQ is required to publish and annually update a map of biosolid land application property sites on a publicly available website.

The DEQ shares that a fiscal impact is estimated at a first year impact of \$2,201,206 for software and initial onboarding of FTE, and a reoccurring impact of \$201,206 to maintain the FTE.
