**Bill Summary and  
Fiscal Analysis:**

SB 1821 states that any bench trial conducted relating to the termination of parental rights waiving their right to a jury trial is to be conducted by a separate court than a court that conducted previous hearings on the matter. The measure also states that any judge who presides over a hearing where the rules of evidence do not apply will not preside over a subsequent trial where the rules of evidence do apply.

The measure yields no fiscal impact.
