### **Bill Summary and Fiscal Analysis:**

SB 1822 authorizes the OMMA to create a research license to facilitate the collection, analysis, and monitoring of patient-reported outcomes related to the use of medical marijuana.

OMMA shares that a fiscal impact is indeterminate at this time, and that modifications to existing license applications or the creation of a new license application will require engagement with the licensing vendor to determine whether any additional costs can be absorbed within existing resources or would require additional legislative appropriations.
