**Bill Summary and  
Fiscal Analysis:**

SB 1847 expands the population covered by the ADvantage program. The measure reduces the minimum age of physically disabled participants to 19 (from 21) and allows individuals to currently reside in an assisted living center rather than only in their own or in a family member's home.

DHS expects a total fiscal impact of \$800,000 to cover this population, with a state share of \$272,000.
