**Bill Summary and
Fiscal Analysis:**

SB 1898 directs the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education to select three state institutions of higher education to establish a Center for Civic Engagement to enhance education in certain fields, provide viewpoints and ideologically diverse resources, foster civic engagement, and assist in ensuring that institutions serve as robust marketplaces of ideas.

The Regents estimate the cost of establishing each center at \$2 million to \$3 million annually. The measure calls for the institutions to establish a center placing the total estimate at a maximum of \$9,000,000.
