**Bill Summary and  
Fiscal Analysis:**

SB 1921 states that all national criminal history record checks done by the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation for access and review purposes will need to be completed prior to the individual receiving and reviewing national criminal history record information. Additionally, this measure increases the fee for criminal history checks from \$15 to \$20, the fee for fingerprint analysis from \$19 to \$25, and establishes a \$55 fee to conduct a national criminal history record with fingerprint analysis done by mail.

The fiscal impact of this measure is an increase to fee revenue of approximately \$1,000,000 to \$1,250,000 annually.
