**Bill Summary and
Fiscal Analysis:**

SB 1924 increases the opt-out amount that state employees authorized to opt-out of the state's basic plan or the health and dental basic plan options in lieu of the flexible benefit amount currently receive, from \$150.00 to \$500.00.

OMES shares that 1,286 state employees are authorized to receive the current opt-out of \$150 as of January 1, 2026, totaling \$2,314,800 per year. If the opt-out amount is increased to \$500 per month, the opt-out amount will total \$7,716,000 per year, an increase of \$5,401,200. Therefore, the fiscal impact is \$5,401,200.
