**Bill Summary and
Fiscal Analysis:**

SB 1936 adds the crime of falsely impersonating oneself as law enforcement personnel to the list of class D1 felonies. A person found guilty of this crime will be subject to a maximum fine of \$10,000 as well as imprisonment.

The Department of Corrections notes any incarceration increases would be dependent on the number of future convictions, and the agency is unable to determine a fiscal impact. The Department has provided the marginal/incremental cost of an incarcerated inmate, which is \$67.26 per day or \$24,549.90 per year.
