## Bill Summary and Fiscal Analysis:

This bill directs the Office of Management and Enterprise Services to secure liability coverage on behalf of students participating in the Apprenticeship, Internships and Mentorships (AIM) program.

OMES shall secure liability insurance on behalf of all sophomore students aged 16 or older, juniors, and seniors from qualifying schools that are permitted to participate in the AIM program.

OMES currently does not provide any liability coverage for student or public educational institutions. The fiscal impact to the agency for the AIM program is estimated at \$300,000 annually for up to 5,000 student participants. Due to the unknown nature of the actual types of apprenticeships, internships, or mentorships being offered, the agency can only provide an estimate based off number of participants.
