### Bill Summary and Fiscal Analysis:

SB1950 prohibits using information broadcasted or collected by an automatic dependent surveillance-broadcast system as a means for calculating, generating, and collecting fees from owners or operators who operate aircraft within the state.

There is no current usage by the ODAA or SOK of the technology/system prohibited by the bill, as a result there is no fiscal impact. The ODAA does anticipate a possible \$1,000,000-\$2,000,000 annual loss of state revenue as a result of the passage of the bill that would have otherwise been collected when the technology/system was implemented.
