**Bill Summary and
Fiscal Analysis:**

SB 1951 requires the Department of Health to implement data collection and produce two reports every three years on the standard of care for women with infertility diagnoses and on the standard of care for women and men seeking reproductive health condition diagnoses, with the first reports coming within two years of the effective date of the measure. The measure also requires all Title X funded facilities to include fertility awareness-based methods and body literacy education as part of covered family planning and reproductive health services. OSDH is also required to expand and coordinate programs to conduct and support research on reproductive health conditions.

OSDH estimates one additional FTE as well as equipment costs for this employee to carry out the provisions of the measure.
