**Bill Summary and
Fiscal Analysis:**

SB 1979 provides that new mining permits or expansion not to be authorized for surface mining, excavation, or blasting within 800 feet of any residence or residentially zoned property, that mining or blasting permits are not authorized for mining or blasting operations within 800 feet of any protected structure, and that the Department of Mines shall not issue a new permit or approve an expansion unless the applicant demonstrates compliance with the requirements laid out in the proposal.

The Department shares that they would experience an increase in administrative and enforcement costs associated with enhanced permitting requirements, rulemaking, public notification oversight, and compliance enforcement. They estimate a fiscal impact of \$45,000.
