Bill Summary and Fiscal Analysis:

SB 1980 states that any person who acquires or retains possession of a gift card, gift certificate, or redemption information of a gift card without the consent of the cardholder or issuer with the intent to defraud will be guilty of larceny. Any person who alters these gift cards will be guilty of forgery in the third degree. A person will be guilty of fraud if they attempt to obtain the redemption information to a gift card or gift certificate from a cardholder or issuer fraudulently. The measure provides that a person shall be guilty of grand larceny if the total value of money or goods obtained through the means described above exceeds \$950.00.

The fiscal impact of this measure is pending.
