ESTIMATED REVENUE IMPACT:
FY27: Unknown decrease in state sales tax revenues
FY28: Unknown decrease in state sales tax revenues

ANALYSIS: The measure would provide a sales tax exemption for sales made to a 501(c)(3) organization that rescues and cares for abandoned animals and seeks to rehome them or provide sanctuary when adoption is not possible.

The total number of organizations providing these animal rescue services in Oklahoma is unknown. While research indicates that numerous such organizations operate throughout the state, there is no centralized database that provides reliable information on their number, expenditures, operational status, or whether they are recognized as tax-exempt under Section 501(c)(3).
