### Bill Summary and Fiscal Analysis:

SB 2033 creates the Predatory Solicitation Prevention Act which prohibits any person from engaging in persistent, repeated communication to solicit a purchase, sale, or investment in real property. The measure establishes a \$600 fine per solicitation. The measure states that 50% of recovered monies will be deposited in the State Health Care Enhancement Fund and 50% will be deposited in the County Clerk's Revolving Fund.

The fiscal impact of this measure is an unknown increase to revenue.
