**Bill Summary and
Fiscal Analysis:**

SB 2041 adds new crimes related to the possession of methamphetamine, cocaine, fentanyl, or other controlled substances to the list of B2 felony offenses.

The Department of Corrections notes any incarceration increases would be dependent on the number of future convictions, and the agency is unable to determine a fiscal impact. The Department has provided the marginal/incremental cost of an incarcerated inmate, which is \$67.26 per day or \$24,549.90 per year.
