**Bill Summary and  
Fiscal Analysis:**

SB 2052 requires that a person arrested for operating a commercial vehicle without a license from a state or territory of the U.S., a valid non-domiciled CDL or nondomiciled commercial learner permit, or by a person who is not proficient in English shall not be released on his or her own recognizance. Establishes a fine and/or term of imprisonment for up to 90 days and requires towing of their vehicle for persons who fail to comply with the provisions of this measure.

To comply with Section 5 of the bill, DPS anticipates a need for two attorneys and two administrative assistants along with accompanying work materials/equipment. This need has an anticipated first year impact of \$436,680 and an annually recurring impact of \$403,080. These impacts will be partially or fully offset by the fines described in Section 5.
