**Bill Summary and  
Fiscal Analysis:**

SB 2061 creates the Oklahoma Food Policy Council within the ODAFF to serve in a advisory and coordinating capacity to create networks of farmers to local organizations to provide sustainable locally grown food to consumers, strengthen coordination between existing programs that support sustainable food production, assess the impact of the production of sustainable food distributed locally on the economic development of the state, assess the utilization of urban and community gardens on improving the health of citizens, and connect producers of sustainable food to farmers markets.

As written, there is no fiscal impact. The measure clarifies that members of the Council are not to receive compensation for service but shall be eligible for reimbursement for travel-related expenses incurred pursuant to the State Travel Reimbursement Act.
